NAPLAN Results

Year 3 and Year 5 students' NAPLAN results were processed and sent home with the students on Tuesday.

NAPLAN measures student achievement in numeracy, reading, writing, spelling, grammar and punctuation, against the four proficiency levels; Exceeding, Strong, Developing and Needs Additional Support. Later this term, the state results will be released so we will be able to analyse how our students performed against state averages and against 'similar schools'.

PYPX2023 - Year 6 Exhibition

On Thursday the Year 6 students will be presenting their PYP Exhibition. This year's theme is based on 'Where We Are in Place and Time'. Students have engaged in a collaborative, transdisciplinary inquiry process that involves them identifying, investigating and offering solutions to real-life issues or problems in the world. All our students will have an opportunity to visit the Year 6 students to hear them present on their inquiry units during the school day next Thursday 2nd August. The Year 6 students will then present to their parents with an open session between 5:00pm and 6:00pm.

AT ASPENDALE GARDENS at AGPS

This term in Visual Arts we will be celebrating BOOK WEEK. The theme is 'READ GROW and INSPIRE'.

Just like Isaiah Firebrace shared in his book COME TOGETHER about his family, his culture and all that is special to him, we would like to do the same.

We will be creating picture story books featuring a page created by each student.
