Asthma / Anaphylaxis / Allergy Plans



Documentation regarding student asthma plans is available from the office. Please update your child's details and return to the office as soon as possible. Parents of anaphylactic children and children with allergies should visit the office to update necessary paperwork and provide appropriate medication to



be kept on hand in the first aid room. Please ensure that the school has medication that is 'in date'.

Student Absences

To assist our school to monitor absences we ask that parents please log in to Compass and register your child's absence through the portal. Alternatively, send a note on the day of your child's return to school, or contact the office, by phone or email, to let us know your child will be absent on the day and the reason for your child's absence. It is a requirement from the Department of Education that all absences are accounted for.

Canteen

We have had to cancel the opening of canteen this week due to staff shortages. From next week, we will be running the canteen 3 days per week, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. This will be a trial for Term 1 and we will review the success of the 3rd day. A reminder that canteen meals can be ordered through the QKR app.

Kingston Council School Crossings

I recently had an email from Kingston Council to inform us that due to the current COVID situation, there may be times when the crossing supervisor may not be able to attend and they may not be able to find a replacement. They assured me that they will do their best to manage staff and crossings to the best of their ability and have procedures in place to move supervisors from low priority crossings to high priority crossings. There is a possibility however that crossings may be unstaffed from time to time until this wave has ceased. Council will do their best to let schools know when crossings will be unstaffed to allow their parents and students to make alternative plans.

Safe Riding of Bikes and Scooters

We ask parents and students to mindful of others when on the pavement areas around the school. At the beginning and end of the day there are large numbers of people moving in different directions around the school. Cyclists need to ride very slowly or walk on the pavements and keep attentive at all times, to avoid any accidents.

It has been wonderful to be back in school this week and get the year off to a good start. I am sure the students have had a busy week, getting back into the school routines and would benefit from some relaxation time during the weekend.


